The NYFF scholarships are designed to assist students in obtaining a college degree and are available on a competitive basis to:

- High School Seniors
- High School Graduates
- College/University Students
- Undergraduate Students

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

1. Type an essay of no less than 500 words about:

“WHAT YOU EXPECT TO GAIN FROM A COLLEGE EDUCATION”

2. Provide Official High School transcript (most recent report card for High School student)

3. Provide three letters of recommendation from teachers or coaches, or employers.

4. Provide a photocopy of the letter of acceptance from the educational institution of your choice. This must be submitted to the NYFF before the acceptance of the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- Applicant must be directly related to an active member of the law enforcement community. This means a parent or relative involved in crime control or reduction and who is directly employed on a full-time basis by a local, state, or federal law enforcement agency, and who is duly sworn and has full arrest powers.
- A one-time award will be granted for \$1,000.
- An impartial panel of judges will evaluate applications.
- The NYFF Scholarship program does not discriminate based on a person's sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability.

- Scholarship recipients must consent to the use of their name and likeness by the NYFF for promotional and advertisement purposes.
